



Odometer Announcement Guidelines

When a unit is checked into DAAR, we validate miles with all check in slips as well as record any announcements provided by the seller and documented by photo.

Actual Mileage Announcement: If a title comes in on a unit with one or more miles recorded and the title cannot be corrected to match the announced mileage, the sale can be unwound if the buyer does not agree to keep with the additional mileage no matter what year the unit is.

No Mileage Announcement: If a title comes in on a unit 2010 and older with one or more miles recorded and “Actual Mileage” was **not** announced then the recorded miles will be “Exempt” and the unit will stay sold.

Our Error: If an odometer error was made on at title by our title staff when assigning the title to the buyer, we will make any and all corrections to the title at no fee to the buyer/seller.

Inoperable Vehicle: If a unit is sold with an announcement of “Inoperable” and the buyer wants to correct/record the odometer reading they **must first reach out to the title department** to have them pull the title from being worked and note the system. They then must present a photo of the instrument panel with the functional odometer reading or bring the unit back in so the title department can validate the reading. If they want AutoCheck and/or Carfax report corrected, they will need to pay the fees for this service. ***Exception to this rule, any unit 2010 and older will automatically be exempted.**
